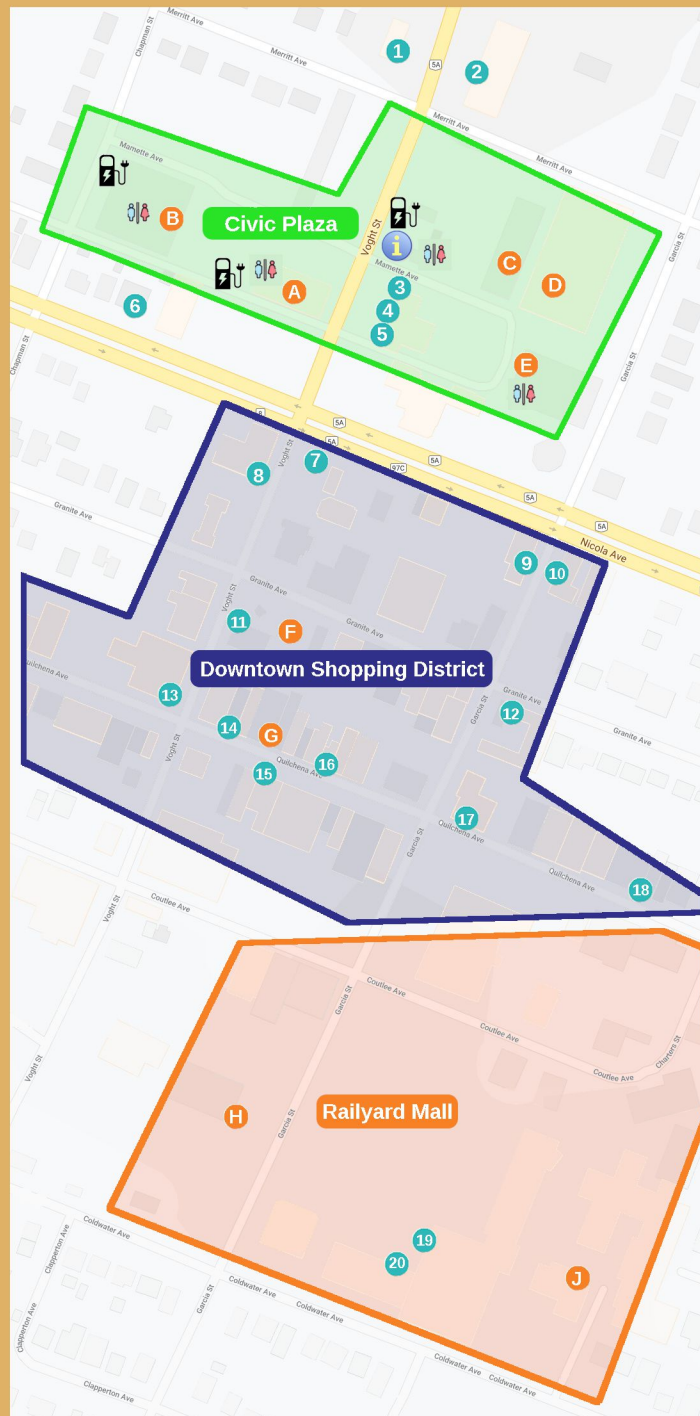

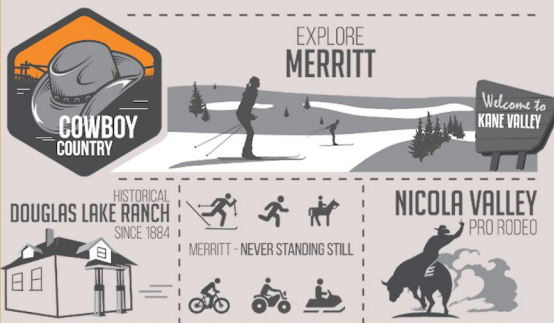

1. A&W

Famous North American restaurant chain serving 100% beef patties and iconic A&W root beer.

2. Mughal Gardens

3. Subway

Eight unique IPAs available, non alcoholic options and snacks also available.

Featuring Foothills Creamery's famous hard ice creams. Uncompromising quality and made in-store treats.

12. Mary's Corner Cafe + Catering

Relaxed local eatery with frequent daily specials. Everything from light snacks to full meals.

13. Dixie Lee's Chicken & Fish

Longstanding local establishment featuring a range of lunch and dinner options from pizza to samosas to their namesake chicken & fish.

14. Panago Pizza

Canadian pizzeria chain originating in BC with takeout, delivery and dine-in options.

15. Coldwater Hotel Restaurant

Established 1908, the Coldwater Hotel Restaurant is a fully functioning bar and restaurant. Many guests visit every year to take a picture of the iconic building.

16. Canada Cafe

Family-owned Chinese restaurant featuring some western cuisine options. Popular for families and travelers looking for a comfortable sit-down meal.

17. Lynda's Cafe

Friendly cafe serving familiar breakfast, brunch and lunch staples, featuring an extensive and hearty omelette menu.

18. Brambles Bakery & Cafe

Timeless bakery with fresh small batch artisan breads, soups, and beverages prepared daily.

19. Mandolin's Bagel & Coffeehouse

Popular lunch spot serving hot and cold drinks and a variety of can't-miss bagels with several spread options.

Attractions

A. City Hall

Located in the middle of downtown Merritt and across from the Baillie House, the City Hall features electric vehicle charging and public use washrooms.

B. Merritt Civic Centre

The Merritt Civic Centre is where many of Merritt's events are hosted, from dances to dinners to performances – check the online Tourism Merritt event calendar to see if your visit coincides with any exciting events!

C. Merritt Curling Centre

Merritt's Curling Club has existed as long as the city itself, being formed in November of 1911 – this Club, as well as non-members, visitors, and those new to the sport, have converged here to play since the building's construction in 1959.

D. Nicola Valley Memorial Arena

Home to the Merritt Centennials, the Memorial Arena hosts community events from hockey games to dances and conferences.

E. Nicola Valley Aquatic Centre

Featuring leisure pools a lap pool, hot tubs, a full gym, and sauna, the Aquatic Centre is a great way to spend a day.

F. Spirit Square

The site of many events including weekly summer music concerts, Spirit Square's benches are a great place to take a break and enjoy the city.

G. Canadian Country Music Hall of Fame

Featuring dozens of plaques and over a hundred total artist features, the Canadian Country Music Hall of Fame is a popular destination for visitors interested in Canada's influence in country music.

H. Thompson-Nicola Regional Library – Merritt Branch

The Merritt Branch of the TNRD Library network features thousands of titles on hand to be checked out, from books to magazines to videos and more, as well as a computer lab and frequent community events and programs.

I. Merritt Visitor Centre at the Baillie House

Experience the unique western charm of a home largely unchanged since the early 1900's. Take a complimentary tour and hear the story of the Baillies, then relax in the Visitor Centre.

J. Nicola Valley Museum & Archives
